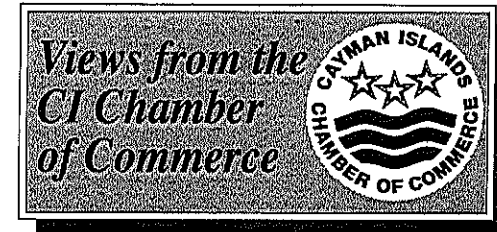


# Constitutional forum

In the Chamber's article appearing in the 11 September issue of the *Caymanian Compass*, we stated our position on public forums to discuss the topic of the proposed changes to the Constitution.

Regrettably, the Chamber found it necessary to postpone the meeting, originally scheduled for 12 September, in the absence of one of the selected speakers and in recognition of its responsibility to the public to ensure that differing views are presented and to receive answers to the varying questions they ask.
